

World Cyber Gamer Nordic presents the Nordic Counter-Strike 1.6 Finals

World Cyber Games is the biggest and most respected e-sports tournament in the world. Over 1.5 million gamers from all around the world take part in the WCG qualifications from which 800 players representing 80 countries are selected to compete in the world championship finals held this year in Los Angeles, USA.

This year the Nordic countries of Finland, Sweden and Norway are represented by a joint team. The qualifications to this team will be held at the ASSEMBLY Summer 2010 festival, where over 5000 spectators will witness the clash of the best Nordic teams competing for a spot in the 'Olympics' of eSports.

Two teams from each of Norway, Sweden and Finland will enter this Nordic Final. From Norway the qualified teams are Oslo Lions eSportsKlubb and Expert-Gaming, who qualified to the final from The Gathering 2010 computer festival.

Finland will have two qualification events, each qualifying one team for the Nordic Final. The first qualification will be held at the Solid Mojo LAN party at the Energia-Areena at Vantaa, on May 14th – 16th. Registration for the tournament is open for Finnish Counter-Strike teams until April 25th. Gaming.fi will broadcast the qualification matches live with commentary.

Solid Mojo has over 1000 computer places making it one of Finland's largest LAN parties. The party plays host to a wide variety of competitions and programs and has a large prize pool: the CS 1.6 qualification prizes alone are over 1750 € in cash.

The qualification event for Sweden and the second qualification event for Finland will be announced later by WCG Nordic.
